



Palestinian children and the seeds of hate

In the conflict between Israel and the Palestinians, the world has witnessed the horrors of Palestinians committing suicide with the intent of killing as many Israelis as possible. This has been done both by suicide bombers and by no-return killing sprees. Being openly and actively promoted by the Palestinian leadership one may ask how they could instil such a desire that conflicts with the basic survival instinct of every human being? During the past few years of armed conflict the Palestinian Authority [PA] has been making a paramount effort to convince their own children

that there is no greater achievement than to die for Allah in battle, known as Shahada. "Ask for death" has been the PA's message to its children via all the media at its disposal, including children's TV broadcasting, the educational system, cultural programmes, directives from political and religious leaders and even from within the family. Polls show 72-80% of Palestinian children would sacrifice their lives for Allah. The PA has done everything in its power to teach hatred to adult and young minds; a monstrosity of historical proportions, planting the seeds of the next war.

Kindergarten and schools

The textbooks used in the Palestinian Authority school system, from elementary through high school, are replete with strong expressions of hatred towards Israel, negation of its right to exist and praise for the struggle against it, as well as anti-Semitic expressions against the Jews. The State of Israel is portrayed as the result of a colonialist anti-Arab plot that stole Palestinian land to split the Arab world. The calls to fight and eliminate Israel through Holy War (Jihad) and Martyrdom for Allah (Shahada) appear frequently in the PA schoolbooks, glorifying Shahada as an

ideal to be sought. The fortunate are those who are killed - attaining "Martyrdom". Poems and songs taught to the children follow the same theme. In addition there is a separate recurring theme: the children are taught to fight and conquer Israel's capital, Jerusalem. The state of Israel does not exist, but replaced with "Palestine". The chart in the atlas lists all the countries in the world and their capitals. It includes Palestine whose capital is Jerusalem, but Israel is missing. A few examples of statements about Jews: "One must beware of the Jews, for they are treacherous and disloyal", "Jews

are like donkeys according to Allah", "The final and inevitable result will be the victory of the Muslims over the Jews". Thus, Palestinian youth are educated from birth in an atmosphere of religious and nationalist incitement, with no trace of anything positive regarding Israel, which results in a deepening of their hatred towards Israel, a fanning of the flames of violence and encouragement and justification of terrorism against the State of Israel and against Jews.

Palestinian Authority TV

It is often said these days that suicide bombers are the products of Israeli military action and social oppression. This ignores a Palestinian Authority that is purposefully inciting its people to hatred and martyrdom. Palestinian Authority Television is awash in propaganda, using its station to teach children to hate Israelis and Jews by repeatedly broadcasting libelous music videos and propaganda clips depicting Israeli soldiers as cold-blooded murderers, especially of children and the elderly. Public-service announcements sound the call to martyrdom, and the celebration and reward of child martyrs has been a persistent and disturbing theme of PA TV programming. Jews are inherently evil and the cursed enemy of Allah. Jewish traditions are distorted, the Holocaust denied. Killing Jews is presented as a religious obligation and the battle against Israel is said to be not over borders, but part of Islam's war against Jews. Many cultural programmes idolise Shahada and the Shahids - those who died for Allah. The regular PA TV programming includes song and dance accompanying scenes of violence and words glorifying willingness to die for Allah. Clips that encourage children to fight are broadcast

several times on a daily basis. Subliminal messages have been outlawed in the West for half a century. Yet the Palestinian Authority uses subliminal messages to teach hatred and promote the murder of Jews. Israel's Supreme Court has imposed very strict limitations on use of force during interrogation of Palestinian terrorists, and then only in cases defined as "ticking bombs", when the terrorist has information of a bombing that is under way or being planned. Still the PA broadcasts libelous films with actors depicting "Israeli torture". In scenes from a Palestinian movie shown on a TV culture programme, actors portray Israeli soldiers murdering a couple and raping a young girl. Note: There has never been a rape accusation against Israeli soldiers.

part of your soil, I have drenched with all my blood, and we shall march as warriors of Jihad". "On your life, I foresee my death. But I quickly march towards my death. Am I afraid? Life has little value because I'm returning to my Lord and my people will know I'm a hero."

Palestinian children have embraced the veneration of Shahada from an early age, as expressed in the "Shahid Game," in which children act out a Shahid's funeral. The "Shahid Game" as described in the PA media:

"Nada, a seven year old girl, says to her friends: 'Let's play the Shahid Game!' The children fetch an old sheet that they spread on the ground, and then they argue who will play the Shahid. Fa'iz, 6 years old, says: 'You were the Shahid yesterday, today it's my turn! I'm younger than you. I will be the one to die!'. "Then he lies down on the sheet. Nada, playing the role of 'mother of the Shahid' cries and yells as the rest of the children lift Fa'iz up, wrapped in his 'shrouds'. The children walk, chanting 'Allah Akbar! Make way for the Shahid!' as they brandish plastic toy Kalashnikov rifles"

Religious leadership

In Islam, religious teaching is not limited to the realm of worship, as social and military activities are considered within Islam's jurisdiction. Palestinian religious leaders have been a driving force, through their religion classes and their televised sermons, in calling for Palestinians to kill

Jews, especially through suicide bombings. They teach that seeking death for Allah as a Shahid is every Moslem's duty, and direct these messages to children as well. Religious rulings, fatwas, have also established that children are obligated to participate in these activities.



"The believer was created to know his Lord and to uphold Islam to be a Shahid, or intend to be a Shahid. If the Moslem does not yearn for Shahada, he will die as in the Jahiliya [pre-Islam faith]. We must yearn for Shahada and request it from Allah. If we truthfully request it of Allah, He will grant us its rewards even if we die in bed. [Allah] has planted within our youth the love of Jihad, the love of Shahada. Our youth have turned into bombs, they blow themselves up among them [Israelis] day and night."

"I was uplifted when a youth said: 'Oh, Sheikh, I am 14 years old. I have 4 more years and then I will blow myself up among Allah's enemies, I will blow myself up among the Jews.' I said to him, 'Oh young child, may Allah let you merit Shahada and let me merit Shahada...' All the weapons must be aimed at the Jews, Allah's enemies, the cursed nation in the Koran, whom Allah describes as monkeys and pigs, worshippers of the calf and idol worshippers... Nothing will deter them except the colour of blood in their filthy nation... unless we blow ourselves up, willingly and

as our duty, in their midst...' May Allah make the Moslem rule over the Jew. We will blow them up in Hadera, we will blow them up in Tel-Aviv and in Netanya so that Allah will make us masters over this riff-raff. We will fight against them and rule over them until the Jew will hide behind the trees and stones and the tree and stone will say: 'Moslem! Servant of Allah, there is a Jew behind me, kill him.' We shall enter Jerusalem as conquerors, and Jaffa as conquerors, and Haifa as conquerors and Ashkelon as conquerors... Blessings upon he who educates his sons in the path of Jihad and Shahada!"

Summer camps

The Palestinian children are receiving indoctrination and education in terror at summer camps organised by the Palestinian Authority, Hamas and Islamic Jihad, among others. Summer camp, where children traditionally participate in songs and fun games, has been warped by the Palestinians into a sickening display of hatred and intolerance. At the summer camps, children are encouraged to learn how to play a role in terrorist

attacks, learn how to shoot guns and given instruction in how to blow up Israeli buses and settlements. Suicide bombers are also glorified with a number of camp groups being named for them. Summer camps are currently training 8 to 12-year-olds for suicide bombings. Since the outbreak of violence, terrorists have dispatched 29 suicide bombers younger than 18.

Celebrating Shahada and suicide bombers

Mothers Express Joy at Son's Death for Allah. In order to present Shahada-seeking as a popular and broad-based phenomenon, the Palestinian Authority gives significant media exposure to one mother who was quoted in the Palestinian Authority official daily, Al.Hayat Al.Jadida, as saying "The best Mother's Day present I got this year was the news of the death of my son Abbas as a Shahid." Glorifying Shahadas by dressing their children as suicide bombers is a chilling reminder that parents are an integral part of the hate indoctrination.

Human shields

The Palestinian Authority has intentionally mobilised Palestinian children to man the front line in its struggle against Israel, frequently using them as shields in order to protect Palestinian gunmen. A very cynical tactic since a child hurt or killed will be good PR and benefit them. The world only sees stone-throwing children operating against soldiers, but never the snipers hiding behind them. Children are also directly helping terrorists in their attacks. This is for example done by standing in front of the terrorists while they assemble rocket launchers or covering them when they escape. Groundfloors and underground rooms in kindergartens, schools and hospitals are used for explosive labs & factories. When appearing in public, top terrorist leaders are known to have children and minors nearby as insurance against attacks. Using naive children and adolescents to smuggle weapons and bombs is another way of abuse. It is a phenomenon widely practice since the beginning of the uprising.

Conclusion

Consequently, when we view children on PA TV who say they want to destroy Israel, to liberate Tel Aviv, Jaffa, Haifa, Acre, and Ramle, and to expel the Jews, we are seeing children who are accurately regurgitating the sentiments absorbed and reinforced throughout PA society. Indeed, years of anti-Israel indoctrination have been alarmingly effective in teaching Palestinian youth that the Jews have no link to Israel, that Israel has no right to exist and that the overriding goal of the next generation - even at the cost of their lives - should be to eliminate Israel. Systematically using children as part of the guerrilla warfare campaign shows the total lack of respect for human life, and ranks the Palestinians as one of the world's worst child abusers in modern times.

The following is from an interview on PA TV in 2002:
 Question: "Mr. President, what message would you like to send to the Palestinian people, in general, and, in particular, to the Palestinian children?"
 Arafat: "...This child, who is grasping the stone, facing the tank — is it not the greatest message to the world when that hero becomes a Shahid? We are proud of them..."



In 1974, the PLO (Palestine Liberation Organisation) adopted the Stage Plan:

- Stage 1: Through violent struggle, establish a "combatant national authority" over any territory that is "liberated" from Israeli rule.
- Stage 2: Use the territory of the national authority as a base for attacks on Israel.
- Stage 3: Provoke an all-out war to "liberate all Palestinian territory" - that is, destroy Israel.

- 1980 Arafat to El Mundo, Venezuela: "Peace for us means the destruction of Israel. We are preparing for an all-out war, a war which will last for generations."
- 1980 Arafat in Beirut: "The victory march will continue until the Palestinian flag flies in Jerusalem and in all of Palestine from the Jordan River to the Mediterranean Sea and from Rosh Hanikra to Eilat".
- 1983 Arafat: "The war of attrition against the Zionist enemy will never cease."
- 1993 Arafat signed the Oslo Accords. On the day he signed this agreement on the White House lawn, he made a radio broadcast in Arabic assuring listeners that the Oslo Accords are Stage 1 of the Stage Plan.
- 1994 Arafat received the Nobel Peace Prize together with Israeli Prime Minister Yitzhak Rabin and Foreign Minister Shimon Peres for their achievements on the Peace Agreement between Israel and Palestine.
- 1994 Arafat spoke in a mosque in Johannesburg, South Africa: "I do not regard this agreement as any more valid than the agreement that was signed between our prophet Muhammed and the Koraish." In the Seventh Century, Muhammad contracted the treaty of Khudaibiya with the Arabian tribe of Koraish. Two years later, he attacked and destroyed the tribe of Koraish.
- 1994 Arafat wrote to groups opposing the Oslo

- Accords: "In order to achieve the goal of returning to Palestine, all of us sometimes have to grit our teeth. But it is forbidden that this harm the continued struggle against the Zionist enemy. Cooperation and understanding between the PLO and the rejectionist organisations is what will lead to the speedy retreat of Israel from the occupied territories in the first stage, until the establishment of a Palestinian state with its capital in Jerusalem. Only a state like that can then continue the struggle to remove the enemy from all Palestinian lands."
- 1995 Arafat told Arab diplomats stationed in Stockholm, Sweden of the PLO plan: "To eliminate the State of Israel and establish a purely Palestinian state. We will make life unbearable for Jews by psychological warfare and population explosion; Jews won't want to live among us Arabs."
- 1995 Arafat in a Voice of Palestine broadcast: "The struggle will continue until all of Palestine is liberated. From the river to the sea"
- 1996 Yasser Arafat in a speech at the Dehaishe refugee camp near Bethlehem: "War! War! Continue the struggle!"
- 1997 Arafat claims: "Our law is a Jordanian law that we inherited, which applies to both the West Bank and Gaza, and sets the death penalty for those who sell land to Israelis. It is our right to defend our land."

- 1997 Arafat on Voice of Palestine: "I now see the walls of Jerusalem, the mosques of Jerusalem, the churches of Jerusalem. My brothers! With blood and with spirit we will redeem you, Palestine! Yes, with blood and with spirit we will redeem you Palestine!"
- 1997 Arafat on Palestinian Television "It is important that we organise our homes and our movement so that we can more and more endure the coming battle, which we shall initiate. We must say these things because great battles lie before us, and it will be now more difficult than in the past... let us each commit one to another and let us commit ourselves before Allah and the Palestinian people that we shall lead the coming battle as we have led previous battles. An oath is an oath and a promise is a promise. The whole world stands on us, while they are alone. They are afraid, but we are not. We cling to the oath and the promise. The Palestinian people are faithful to their oath, the one which we swore upon the first day when the initial shot was fired and the first of our martyrs fell. I must say these things so that you will know where, how, and in which direction our movement is heading. We are marching together to Jerusalem, Jerusalem, Jerusalem."
- 2000 The Palestinian War of Terror starts.
